Spectator on the city stage

The diggings carried out by the archaeologist Ștefan Kovács confirmed the fact that the present territory of the city of Tîrgu Mureș has been inhabited from prehistoric times. A series of dwellings, bone remains, pottery vessels, flint and bronze tools and artifacts, and small clay statues were discovered, dating back to the year 2000 BC. The archaeological sites have revealed human traces from the polished Stone Age, the Bronze and Iron Age. Some of the unearthed vestiges belong to the Criș culture, the oldest Neolithic culture in Romania.

Archaeological finds in Cristești, the citadel of Morești, Cipău and Sântana de Mureș certify the continuity of the local population within this area even after the Aurelian withdrawal. The citadel of Morești near Tîrgu Mureș confirms the existence of some forms of administrative organization at the time of the migrating tribes' invasion.

In 1482, Matthias Corvinus granted the town the



right to hold fairs three times a year. In 1486, he exempted the inhabitants from paying customs. The town was known as Murăș-Oșorhei till the Interwar period.

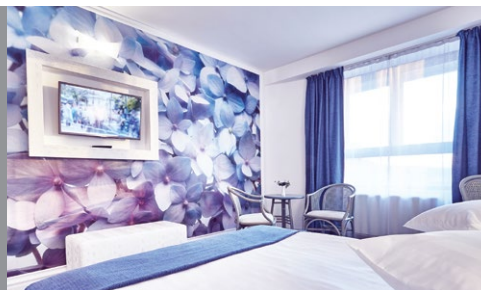
Avram Iancu and the other Romanian leaders who have studied or worked in the town of Mureș used consistently the name of Oșorhei, derived from the Hungarian word "vásárhely" (pronounced "vașarhei"), meaning "fair". The name of Tîrgu Mureș was adapted during the interwar administration. The town of Tîrgu Mureș has a rich offer in terms of tourism related activities. One of the main tourist attractions in town is the Historical Center where one can find the Roses Square and many Baroque, Neoclassical and Secessionist buildings, such as: St John the Baptist Church, the Tower of the Franciscan Church, the Culture Palace and the former Town Hall, which create a typical dualist period atmosphere.

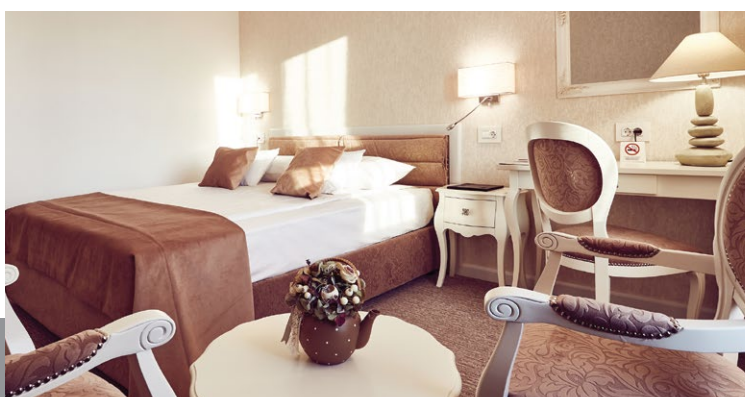
